

## Parent Roster Positions for the 2019/2020 Season

To ensure that the children have a safe and rewarding learning experience, it is mandatory for one parent from each family to nominate for a fortnightly roster duty during competition mornings/twilight meets. Please be aware that **Little Athletics is a parent intensive sport! However it is lots of fun working with other parents and to teach our athletes the importance of volunteering in the community. Each Family will have 7 duty timeslots over the season.**

The following roster positions are available for the 2019/2020 Season (see tables below). You can pick either **Roster 1 or Roster 2**. The same duties apply for each roster. Please check the dates below carefully before choosing your roster.

We have a new coaching/training plan being implemented this season. If parents wish to take on a role as a coach/assistant coach or age-group co-ordinator or manager please let the centre know. Please note these rosters are a weekly commitment. We also have a student roster list for parents who cannot do their roster duty and wish to pay a student.

Please do not be concerned if you know little about athletics. There will be others in the same position and help is never too far away! Each area has a key official to help and all the rules are available on our website.

Unless specified each roster starts at 10 mins prior to the beginning of competition i.e. 7.50 am for a minimum of 3 hours i.e. until 11am or until the competition finishes. Please note some sites do run over this time and parents are expected to stay until the completion of the events. If your site finishes early you will be asked to pack up your site and report to the Arena Manager to help on another site.

All parents are expected to sign in and out of their roster in the orange folders at the Centre Administration Desk each and every time they are on roster. If parents are unable to do a roster they are asked to swap with another parent from the alternate roster (available on the website) or contact club administration by email. The full details are listed on our Parent Roster tab on the website Parent Roster Information.
